The human genome encodes 57 p450 genes divided among 18 families, which together account for the diversity of substrates metabolized. p450 is the primary conjugating enzyme in phase I metabolism and detoxification of endogenous and exogenous compounds, and are primarily localized to the inner membranes of mitochondria and the ER. Eukaryotic microsomal cytochrome p450 enzymes receive electrons from the FAD- and FMN-containing enzyme NADPH:cytochrome p450 reductase (CPR).

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
