# IL-1β (mouse),(recombinant)

IL-1 $\beta$  is produced by activated macrophages as a proprotein and cleaved by caspase-1. IL-1 $\beta$  is an important mediator of the inflammatory response, and is involved in a variety of cellular activities including: cell proliferation, differentiation, and apoptosis. The induction of cyclooxygenase-2 (PTGS2/COX2) by IL-1 $\beta$  in the CNS is found to contribute to inflammatory pain hypersensitivity.
